

Course Rules and Tournament Procedures

No littering. This includes cigarette butts.

Out-of Bounds. Any water in any creek bed or pond is OB. In particular, water that sometimes runs through RM 2, 3, 4, 10, 16 and 18 is OB. Water in small puddles in fairways will be considered casual. Specifically, any water that collects in the fairway of RM 5, 6, or 18 is considered not in a creek bed and is casual.

~~String indicating OB on creek/pond holes supersedes water if less water is present.~~

There is no string OB in 2010.

Beyond the property line is OB. The bottom of the fence line is OB, as defined by the OB side of the nearest fence posts.

The yard around the small house is OB. The bottom of the fence line defines OB.

The field is OB on CH 1, 2, etc. The field is **in-bounds** on CH 18. The bottom of the fence line defines OB.

There is no 2 meter rule.

Mandatories. There are mandatories on RM 12 (left) – drop zone is the tee; and CH17 (right) – drop zone is the tee (re-tee).

Casual. All cactus beds are casual. Former cactus beds are casual (that is, cactus beds that have been mowed over and still have cactus remnants).

Rolling Meadow Course

Across the creek is OB on #1. Across the creek on is OB on #8, up to where the creek bends. Rope denotes OB line (marked with red tape).

Mandatory on #12 (left) – drop zone is the tee.

Circ Hill Course

Mandatory on #17 (right) – drop zone is the tee.

Field is in-bounds on #18, OB on all other holes. Be sure gate is latched when exiting field.

Finals: The top 36 Advanced (plus ties) will play the Hill. Holes #1 - #6 will be Best Shot, #7 - #12 Worst Shot, #13 - #18 Best Disc.

The top sixteen Intermediate (plus ties), and the top two Advanced Women (plus ties) will play the front of the Meadow. #1- #3 Worst Shot, #4 - #6 Best Disc, #7-#9 Best Shot.

The top eight Advanced Masters (plus ties) and the top six Advanced Grand Masters (plus ties) will play the back of the Meadow. #10 - #12 Best Disc, #13 - #15 Best Shot, #16 - #18 Worst Shot.

Tees: Intermediate, Advanced Master, Advanced Women, and Advanced Grand Master will all play from the white tees. Advanced Men will play from the Blue Tees.
